Applications will be kept active for consideration within the department until October 31, 2020. The number of positions varies depending on the needs of the department. Applicants must resubmit a new application each year beginning November 1 to retain eligibility.

**Basic Qualifications:** 

Appointees must have completed all requirements for a PhD (or equivalent) except the dissertation, at the time of application.

Additional Qualifications: PhD must be conferred by appointment start date.

Preferred Qualifications: Include an outstanding specialized research record or demonstrated research in the areas of Materials Science and Engineering, which includes the preferred research areas of electronic and photonics materials, inorganic materials, macromolecular and biomolecular materials, and structural materials.
